AmeriHealth now offers National Access

July 1, 2008

Beginning September 1, 2008, AmeriHealth will provide access to physicians, facilities, and ancillary services throughout the continental United States. When groups purchase the **National Access Rider**, members can receive services from more than 690,000 physicians and 3,800 hospitals at their in-network benefits level.*

The National Access Rider is available with PPO and POS Plus plan designs, including:

- 51+: All PPO and POS Plus plans
- SEH: POS Plus split-copay plans 30/50, 25/50, 20/40, 15/30, and coinsurance options 1, 2, and 3

The National Access Rider will replace the existing New York Access Rider. Effective September 1, 2008, groups and members currently participating in the New York Access program will be transitioned into the National Access program at no additional cost. We will notify affected groups and members of this enhancement as early as August 1, 2008. Member mailings will include new member ID cards reflecting the change.

AmeriHealth has contracted with Multiplan to use its PHCS national network, which includes

more than 439,000 specialists and approximately 254,000 primary care physicians.

Following are some of the many services available through the National Access program:

- physician office visits
- inpatient/outpatient facility
- physical therapy/occupational therapy
- radiology
- laboratory

- Behavioral health: Magellan Behavioral Health, Inc.
- Vision *(if applicable)*: Davis Vision
- Pharmacy *(if applicable)*: FutureScripts®
- Dental *(if applicable)*: United Concordia
